

Student Citizen Breakfast – Thursday, April 30, 2009 University Plaza Hotel and Conference Center

This year will mark the 12th year of the Student Citizen Breakfast. Thirty-three Middle School students in the 6th, 7th and 8th grades and their parents, Chamber business members, and school administrators attend this annual event. We expect approximately 170 in attendance this year. The following Clintonville schools will be represented: Calumet Christian School, Clintonville Academy, Dominion Middle School, Immaculate Conception School and Our Lady of Peace School.

Students are selected by their school, and recognized for their leadership and academic achievement, and most importantly for their involvement in the community. Two students from each grade and each school will be honored with the exception of Dominion which will have three students from each grade because it is larger than any of the other schools.

As in years past, the student honorees will receive:

- A goody bag that includes items from chamber businesses, such as pens, pencils, key chains, bookmarks, notepads, coupons, etc.
- A breakfast program that includes photos and bios of each student honoree.
- A Good Citizenship certificate which they receive from their assigned Chamber Business Sponsor.
- A power point presentation that will highlight each of the Clintonville Middle Schools and each of our student honorees.
- A “good citizenship” medal and ribbon presented by the Business Awards sponsors.
- A group photo of our Student Honorees so it can be published in the local newspaper.

Because the power point presentation and the good citizen medals are an additional cost, the Chamber is looking for additional business sponsors. We have outlined the sponsorship types on the accompanying sheet. We hope that you will consider being involved in this wonderful program this year.
