Clintonville Incorporated, a non-profit charitable entity, is newest of the above organizations, having been created only months ago. The purpose of the organization is to implement urban studies... such as the market study/action plan for N. High Street completed last year with the city's assistance. A copy of the study is available at the Whetstone Library.

Many of the 16 members of the board of trustees are also affiliated with the other organizations mentioned above. Because it is critical that the organization have both input and support from the Chamber and the Commission, the bylaws provide that each designate a Vice-Chairperson who also serves as a member of the executive committee. The current Vice-Chairpersons are respectively

Scott Smith and Paul Carringer. The bylaws also created four operating committees - Organization - Paul Dolby, Design - Vince Papsidero, Marketing - Clare Balombin and Economic Restructuring - Joe Williams. Officers are Pat Kearns-Davis, Joe Williams, D Searcy, and Paul Dolby.

Recurring themes that will be heard from **Clintonville Incorporated** are: "A healthy business district protects property values in surrounding residential neighborhoods" and "Experience Clintonville: A Great Neighborhood for Business!"
