performance. Dianne Kadonaga — Certified Kripalu yoga teacher, licensed occupational therapist for 13 years, ARTC Piano Teachers Diploma

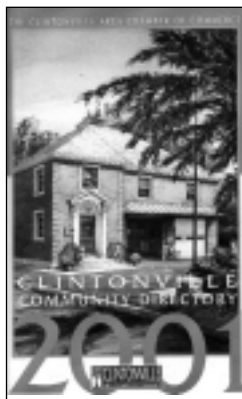
First Job: Ernest — Working in an ice cream shop. Dianne — Teaching piano lessons.
